Dues are \$100 for active members and \$40 for reserve members. You have options. You may send your check to Treasurer Adele Little, 2805 VenemanAvenue, Modesto, CA 95356 or Assistant Treasurer Lynn Lysko, 2328 Lovers Point Lane, Modesto, CA 95356. If you wish to pay with a credit card, you may pay either Janice Freeman or Lynn. Both are set up with Square to take your payment.

Of the dues collected, Eta Mu Chapter can only retain in its budget \$30 for active members and \$6 for reserve members. The bulk of the funds is paid to the international and state levels of the organization. For this reason, if you feel inclined to provide additional support to Eta Mu, you may include a voluntary contribution with your dues. A contribution of any amount will be appreciated. In the 2018-2019 fiscal year, members contributed a total of \$460 above and beyond their dues. Their generosity gave the budget a substantial boost.
